

Call for Applications

Accepting applications for a qualification-based competition in the career of teaching staff in the higher education for the position of adjunct professor, in the field of Methods Quantitative (MQ_ESCE), in the form of an employment contract in public functions for an indefinite period, to perform functions at School of Business Administration the Instituto Politécnico de Setúbal.

- 1. Under the terms of section a) nº 1 of article 6º of the Recruitment and Appointment Regulations for Career Academic Staff of the Polytechnic Institute of Setubal (Instituto Politécnico de Setúbal IPS), as published in the Diário da República, 2ndseries, nº 35, of 18 February 2011, as set out in my dispatch of 21/06/2024, invites applications for the above post within a period of thirty working days from the publication of the present announcement in the Diário da República. The position, which was created but not yet filled within the academic staff of the IPS, is governed by the career structure of the national polytechnic higher education sector at the adjunct professor level, in the field of Methods Quantitative (MQ_ESCE) and is covered by a public sector employment contract of indeterminate duration.
- Location School of Business Administration, situated on the Setubal Campus of the Polytechnic Institute of Setubal (Escola Superior de Ciências Empresariais – Instituto Politécnico de Setúbal).
- 3. Number of posts to be filled 3
- Contract regime Public sector employment contract of indeterminate duration, for an initial experimental period of five years according to article 10º-B of Decreto-Lei nº 185/81, of 1 de julho, altered in the Decreto-Lei nº 207/2009, of 31 de agosto, and in the Lei nº 7/2010, of 13 de maio (ECPDESP).
- Job description The adjunct professor will carry out functions set out in section 4 article 3^o of ECPDESP.
- 6. Recruitment requirements The following cumulative requirements determine eligibility such that candidates must:
 - a) Satisfy the requirements set out in subsections b) to e) of article 17^o of Lei Geral do Trabalho em Funções Públicas (LTFP), approved at Lei nº 35/2014, of 20 June;
 - b) Be the holder of a doctorate or hold the title of specialist, in the specified area, or in an area linked to the area specified in the competition.
- 7. Validity of the competition



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- a) The competition is valid only for the position referred to above and ceases when the post has been filled or if applications are insufficient.
- b) The competition can also be terminated by a formally justified decision of the President of the IPS which respects the general principles of Portuguese public administration and the corresponding legal, regulatory and procedural limits.
- 8. Application form:
 - 8.1. Applications must be formalized by filling out form A and form B.
 - 8.2. The application form (form A) must be submitted on paper, written in Portuguese, available on the IPS website, at:

- 8.3. The application (form A) must be accompanied by a simple photocopy of the qualification certificates, as proof that the candidate meets the application requirements referred to in paragraph 6 of this notice.
- 8.4. When preparing the application, the application (form A) must also be accompanied by two copies, in digital format (pendrive) containing the following documents:
 - a) Certificates of qualifications, proving that the candidate meets the requirements referred to in paragraph b) of paragraph 6 of this notice;
 - b) Other diplomas or certificates from the courses referred to in the curriculum vitae, as well as other documents that facilitate the formation of a judgment about the aptitudes of the candidates to exercise the functional content of the category of assistant professor/adjunct professor;
 - curriculum vitae, dated, signed, organized in accordance with the assessment grid, and without containing confidential personal data (namely affiliation, marital status, residence address, and email, cell phone/telephone contacts);



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- d) Work and proof of activities mentioned in the curriculum vitae and in the B-Curriculum Assessment Grid form.
- e) Proposal for a scientific pedagogical project to be evaluated in items 1.7 and 2.4 of the respective evaluation grid.
- 8.5. The candidate's scientific and pedagogical project, as referred to in point 8.4 e), must be a proposal of the activities to be developed during the first five years as an assistant professor at ESCE. The document must highlight the contribution that the candidate intends to make to the development of the disciplinary area in which the competition is open, with particular emphasis on the pedagogical and scientific aspects, taking into account the assessment criteria. The length of the project must be limited to a number of words not exceeding 2,000. Assessment criteria (to be weighted equally): clarity and quality of the presentation/demonstrated knowledge of best pedagogical practices in the area/demonstrated knowledge of the higher education system in which the candidate intends to join and its training objectives/demonstrated knowledge of scientific research in the area and recent contributions of relevance/relevance to the activities that the candidate intends to develop.

and must be completed by the candidates and all proof must have a link to the respective documents.

- 8.7. Applications must be submitted, inside a closed envelope, with the proper identification of the candidate's name, the Notice number published in the Official Gazette and the BEP offer code, in one of the following ways:

- b. Delivered in person to the Recruitment and Selection Service of the People Management Division of the Polytechnic Institute of Setúbal, during office hours, until the deadline set for submitting applications;
- 8.8. In order to promote the most appropriate classification of curricular elements, candidates must organize their curriculum vitae in accordance with the evaluation grid approved by the respective competition jury, as well as present the documents on the pendrives in accordance with that same organization, with the appropriate hyperlinks from the items mentioned in the curriculum vitae to the respective documents.
- 8.9. Failure to present the work and proof of activities mentioned in the curriculum vitae presented by the candidate implies the non-valuation of the elements in each of the items in the assessment grid.
- 8.10. Applications sent by email are not accepted.
- 8.11. Candidates holding a foreign qualification must prove the recognition, equivalence or registration of a doctoral degree, in accordance with applicable legislation, obtained by the deadline for submitting applications for this competition.
- 8.12. False statements will be punished in accordance with the law.
- 9. Selection and ranking criteria:

Each member of the jury individually assigns each candidate a quantitative classification in each criterion, taking into account the evaluation grid where the maximum scores to be attributed to each of the criteria were defined, and substantiates this classification in writing. The jury will only value each activity/action contained in the curriculum vitae presented by the



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candidate once, and it is not possible to evaluate it in more than one evaluation dimension or in its different criteria.

When ordering the candidates admitted to this competition, in absolute merit, each member of the jury orders, with reasons, the list of candidates in descending order of merit, based on their ordered list of/ the candidates that each member of the jury participates in the votes. The jury initially votes for 1st place, then for 2nd place, and so on, until the final ranking of all candidates admitted to the competition and previously approved on absolute merit. The determination of the candidate placed first is made, counting the number of mentions that each candidate obtained for 1st place by the jury in the partial ranking lists, and the candidate who obtains an absolute majority, which wins the competition, and must then be removed from the partial ranking lists and the identical procedure beginning to choose the candidate who will occupy 2nd place, and so on, until the penultimate place.

If no candidate obtains an absolute majority of mentions for a given position:

- A new process begins, only among the candidates who received mentions for that position, after the candidate least mentioned for that position in the previous process has been removed;
- b) If there is a tie between two or more candidates in the least mentioned position, a tiebreaker vote will be held only between them, counting the number of relative first positions of each one, with the least voted being removed;
- c) If there is a tie between two or more candidates in the least voted position, the process outlined in a) is repeated;
- d) If there is a tie between two or more candidates in the position with the least votes, the tie will be broken through the casting vote of the President of the jury, with the candidate being chosen to take part in the subsequent vote for the same place. /a voted by the President.



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The provisional final ranking list contains the final classification obtained by each of the candidates, on a scale of 0 to 100 points, which results from the simple average of the final quantitative scores attributed by each member of the jury to each /one of the candidates.

If the score calculated in the previous point does not respect the final ranking obtained, based on the grid, these candidates will be evaluated and classified jointly and consensually among the members of the jury.

Candidates who obtain a final classification greater than or equal to 50 points are considered approved on absolute merit.
